Contemporary Issues and Challenges in Commercial Law

The Institute of International Shipping and Trade Law (Swansea University) and the Centre for Commercial Law and Financial Regulation (University of Reading) are organizing a joint conference to be held in Swansea on 24-25 September 2025, following a very successful similar event in Reading in 2023, to discuss in global and local challenges in commercial law and practice.
